

The **Artemis Highland 100** is a stunning cycle route encompassing some of the most spectacular and historic areas of the Scottish Highlands.

Most of the route is on minor roads but there are two challenging off-road sections (12km + 21km). All three routes encompass the stunning and remote Glen Lyon. **CHAS:** The Children's Hospice Association Scotland (CHAS) is a Scottish charity established to provide hospice services in Scotland for children with life-limiting conditions.

The CHAS at Home Team helps children and families in the Highlands by providing support to them in their own homes. The Team also provide homecare support to families across Scotland when they need.
